The School of Neuroscience has a formal policy to ensure all students are making progress towards their bachelor's degree. Each student must achieve a minimum grade of C- or higher in the following courses:

\*NEUR 1004 can be satisfied with any First Year Experience course taken at Virginia Tech.

\*\*Computational and Systems Neuroscience majors are required to take MATH 1225 & 1226.

Per Virginia Tech policy, students have 3 attempts for each of the courses above.

- If you have transferred in any of the courses listed above with a C or higher, or have equivalent AP/IB/CLEP credit, you have met the minimum grade requirement.
A withdrawal (W) counts as an attempt.

If these requirements are not met, you will be asked to leave the School of Neuroscience.
